It is an interdisciplinary meeting where interested scientists and clinicians, working with brain tumors, can present their work in poster sessions and oral presentations chosen from submitted abstracts. Furthermore new trends in Neuro-Oncology will be discussed by prominent invited scientists.

Abstract guidelines

- The length of the abstract should not exceed 2500 characters
- Abstracts should be submitted under the headings: Introduction, Material and Methods, Results and Conclusion
- Final abstracts should be sent as a Word document named after the first author to maria.dinche.johansen.03@regionh.dk
- **Abstract deadline: 15th of January 2016**
